From Nate's Pen: We Believe: In God the Holy Trinity

Yesterday, I began my sermon series about foundational Christian doctrine by preaching about the doctrine of God from the book of Jonah. This coming Sunday, I will continue this series with a second message about the doctrine of God, this time focusing on the biblical teaching about the Trinity.

Of all the Christian doctrines, the doctrine of the Trinity is the most difficult to understand. In fact, we cannot understand it completely, for it concerns the very nature of God, who is greater than our minds. This does not mean, however, that the doctrine is unimportant. Far from it. In fact, the biblical teaching about the Trinity has great power and relevance for our lives, for it grows out of the way God has acted in history to reveal himself to us and save us from sin.

Also, I am regularly asked questions about the Trinity by young people, people on the margins of faith, and experienced believers. There is a hunger to understand as best we can what it means that there is one God who exists eternally as a communion of three person: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. On Sunday, I will preach about the Trinity from one of the most profound statements in all of Paul's letters: Galatians 4:4-7. I invite you to spend time reading Galatians 4 this week. Take in the whole chapter, but give special attention to Paul's "trinitarian statement" in verses 4-7.

The good news of the doctrine of the Trinity is 1) that God has involved his entire self in the work of our salvation, and 2) God has made us participants in his divine life, such that we now share in the fellowship of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. This is truth to know, to love, and to live!
