From Nate's Pen: We Believe: In Jesus Christ His Only Son

Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in him, rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving. – Colossians 2:6-7

Jesus Christ is the heart of the Christian faith. It all revolves around him. To believe in Jesus is accept the truth that he is the Christ, the Son of the Living God, and to confess that he is Lord. It is to trust in his death and resurrection for our salvation. To believe in Jesus is also to **set our affections on him** – to love him because he first loved us. Third, to believe in Jesus is to give him our allegiance – to pledge to follow and obey him with our whole lives.

This coming Sunday, I will continue my sermon series on foundational Christian doctrines by preaching about the doctrine of Christ from Colossians 1:15-20. Classically, there are two questions which are central to this doctrine: 1) Who is Jesus? (the question about his person), and 2) What has Jesus done? (the question about his work). Colossians 1:15-20 is a text which brings Jesus' person and work together in a powerful expression of Christian faith.

In order to **love and live the truth** about Jesus, however, we must go further than answering these basic questions. We must also explore how knowing the truth about Jesus' person and work forms and equips us to follow him more faithfully in our daily lives. Thankfully, the book of Colossians also is brimming with wisdom about following Jesus well. So, in preparation for Sunday's sermon, I invite you to spend some time reading Colossians this week. As you do, pay attention to: what the text says about Jesus' identity, what the text says about Jesus' work, and what the text says about following Jesus as his disciples. Pray that God will help you to know, love, and live the truth of Jesus.
